Eye Screening Program at Katugampala Area Estate

An Eye Screening Programme was initiated to empower estate workers in maintaining optimal eye health within the resident estate community, especially among those engaging in unhealthy habits like prolonged screen time or neglecting eye care. Identified issues were promptly addressed, with individuals requiring further intervention referred to specialized hospitals for treatment.
